

ABSTRACT

THE CORRELATION BETWEEN SELF-CONCEPT AND PEER RELATIONSHIP WITH DELINQUENT ADOLESCENT BEHAVIOR (Studies in high school students class X and XI SMK Surya Dharma Bandar Lampung)

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This research aims to know the correlation between self-concept and peer relationships with delinquent adolescent behavior. The method of this research is quantitative approach with eksplanatory, doing research on high school students class X and XI SMK Surya Dharma Bandar Lampung. Data collection techniques in the study using questionnaires, observation, and study of librarianship. Sample research totalling 68 respondents. While data analysis is carried out with the analysis of correlation, multiple linear regression and analysis through statistical data processing program (SPSS). This research also aims to test the theory of symbolic interaction which is done the students of class X and XI at the SMK Surya Dharma. Based on the results of the research note that most students of class X and XI SMK Surya Dharma have a positive self-concept and have a positive peer relationships which of the two variables influence the low delinquent adolescent behavior. In this study, the Ha received and Ho is rejected, meaning that there is correlation between self-concept with delinquent adolescent behavior, and there is correlation between peer relationships with delinquent adolescent behavior.
