ABSTRACT

THE INFLUENCES OF STUDENT'S PERCEPTION ON TEACHER'S SKILL IN MANAGING CLASSROOM AND THE USE OF LEARNING MEDIA TO THE LEARNING RESULTS OF HISTORY SUBJECT IN SOCIAL SCIENCE STUDENTS OF GRADE XI IN ODD SEMESTER IN STATE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL 4 IN BANDAR LAMPUNG IN ACADEMIC YEAR 2011/2012

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The objective of this research is to find out the student's perception on teacher's skill in managing classroom and the use of learning media to the learning results of history subject in grade XI of social science students in odd semester in State Senior High School 4 in Bandar Lampung in academic year 2011/2012.

This research uses a descriptive verification method with *Ex Post Facto* and survey approaches. Population was 197 students and samples according to T. Yamane formula were 132 students. Sampling technique in this research was proportional random sampling. Data were collected using documentation, interview, observation and questionnaire distribution to samples. The first and second hypothesis tests used regression, while the third hypothesis test used F statistic.

The results show that:

- 1. There is an influence between student's perception on teacher's skill in managing classroom and the learning results of social science students of grade XI in State Senior High School 4 in Bandar Lampung in academic year 2011/2012 that is proved by the estimation result of t test indicating that $t_{count} > t_{table}$, or 7.136 > 1.9600.
- 2. There is an influence between the use of learning media and the learning results of social science students of grade XI in State Senior High School 4 in Bandar Lampung in academic year 2011/2012 that is proved by the estimation result of t test indicating that $t_{count} > t_{table}$, or 6.474 > 1.9600.
- 3. There are influences of between student's perception on teacher's skill in managing classroom and the use of learning media to the learning results of social science students of grade XI in State Senior High School 4 in Bandar Lampung in academic year 2011/2012 that is proved by the estimation result of F test indicating that $t_{count} > t_{table}$, or 34.553 > 3.035
