

V. CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1. Conclusions

Considering all data gathered from this classroom action research and the discussion, the researcher draws some conclusions. They are:

1. Chain card game technique can be used to improve students' writing ability. It is supported by the increase of their result from 17 students (42.5%) whose score is 70 or higher in cycle I to 30 (75%) whose score is 80 or higher in cycle II. It also means the result of classroom action research has fulfilled the indicator of the research in cycle II; 70% of the students' score is at least 70 (seventy) or more in arranging jumbled words based on the criteria.
2. Chain card game technique can increase students' ability in constructive content of the writing because they were able to develop the topic appropriately.
3. Chain card game technique can increase students ability in developing organization because they were able to use temporal organization to make their unity cohesive.
4. Chain card game technique can increase students' ability in constructing grammar because they were able to arrange the words into a good structure.

5.2. Suggestions

Referring to the data in the previous chapter and the conclusions, some suggestion are recommended:

1. Considering the advantages of chain card game technique, it is suggested that English teacher apply chain card game technique as an alternative technique in teaching writing. However, the teacher should ask the students to bring dictionary in order that they will not depend on the teacher and their friends in getting information or meaning of the words. The students will be more independent and get more knowledge.
2. The teacher should be strict in monitoring during writing activity. Since all of jumbled words given the same, there is a chance for students who are lazy to cheat on their friends work. In addition, there should be self-awareness to do the writing test individually, so each student can show their real capability in writing. It can be solved by giving the 3 students who did that a punishment, they not do that anymore in the future.
