allocated at least 20 percent of State Budget Revenue and Expenditure

(Budget) in the sector and at least 20 percent of the Budget Incomes and Expenditures

Local (APBD), accordance with the provisions of the Constitution of 1945 Article 31 paragraph 4 which states that governments prioritize the educational budget at least twenty per cent of Budget Revenues and Expenditures and Budget Revenue and Expenditure daerah to meet the needs of national education.
