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The key to success is the development of educational development. One of the national development priorities to improve the human resources as stated in the Development Program Year 2009 is about the human resources development and improvement of quality high school education who received development funds from central and local government

Increase budget spent on education sector the government has not been able to improve the quality of education. Number of students who continue their education at higher levels decreasing, mainly due to the high cost of education which ultimately affects the quality decline in education in Metro City. Education experienced a dilemma because of the limited budgets but in one hand, demanding an increase in quality. So the problem is how the government's policy of Metro City in an effort to improve the quality of education high school visits from the education sector budget allocation.

This research aims to find out the Metro City Government policy in an effort to improve the quality of education high school graduation rates through visits from the education budget, and to see the consistency of government policies City Metro in improving quality of education high school visits from the education development budget allocation of Metro City.

Analysis tools used in this study is a qualitative descriptive analysis, ie analysis that describes the conditions or matters relating to the education sector, government expenditure by using indicators of quality of education is associated as the end result of education or the UN.

The result showed that the education sector budget is not able to meet existing needs. Thus affecting the quality improvement of high school education are expected to Local Government Metro City. This is because the budget allocated for education quality improvement program is used for physical development. Local Government attention to the direct funding for teaching and learning activities (non-physical) still tends to be neglected. This resulted in a marked decrease in the quality of education is also declining value of the average high school examination in the city of Metro.

Suggestion for Local Government and Metro City Metro City Education Department, namely: should the budget for education sector improved again, and prioritize activities that are directed at activities such as: Improving the quality of teachers, improving facilities and infrastructure development (language labs, computers, science laboratory, libraries and others). Improving the quality of the curriculum through textbooks, improving teacher welfare.
