Sexual dysfunction in women is an important reproductive health issues as its relate to the continuity of a woman's reproductive function and influence on the harmony of marriage. More than half of women in a country may experience sexual dysfunction. Use of hormonal contraception method is one of the risk factors that may affect the incidence of sexual dysfunction in user. The aim of this study is to know the relationship between use of injected contraceptives to the incidence of sexual dysfunction by FSFI scoring at UPT Puskesmas II in Kotabumi.

This study is analitic correlative with the cross sectional approach with consequtive sampling technique. The study was conducted in October-November 2015, with 176 respondents. Results of this research is there a significant association between the use of injectable contraceptives to the incidence of sexual dysfunction with p value = 0,000.
