

ABSTRACT

FACTORS RELATED TO STRESS ON STUDENTS' BURDEN OF CLINICAL CLERKSHIP ON INTERNAL MEDICINE SECTION AT DR. H. ABDUL MOELOEK'S PUBLIC HOSPITAL

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Mastery of knowledge, skills, and behavior are influenced by stress when doctors make clinical clerkship. Internal Medicine section is one of the major section of which focuses on cognitive, this can cause stress. Stress classified in eustress and distress. Eustress encourage individuals to adapt, distress makes individual function decreased. Stress on students' burden of clinical clerkship can be caused by role ambiguity, role conflict, quantitative and qualitative workload, and responsibility towards other. Research on students' burden of clinical clerkship on Internal Medicine section to determine factors related stress on students' burden of clinical clerkship on Internal Medicine section at Dr. H. Abdul Moeloek's hospital.

This research was conducted in two periods with 60 respondents on Internal Medicine section, measurements were taken at the eighth week. In this study, the respondents were given a purpose of research. Furthermore, the respondents were given an informed consent sheet and Self Reporting Questionnaire 20 (SRQ-20) and Stress Diagnostic Survey (SDS) to be done charging with guided interview.

The measurement results found that role ambiguity, role conflict, quantitative and qualitative workload, and responsibility towards other not related to stress on students' burden of clinical clerkship on Internal Medicine section at Dr. H. Abdul Moeloek's hospital.
