POLITICAL CULTURE ORANG RIMBA IN NATIONAL PARK BUKIT DUABELAS JAMBI

Orang Rimba is a remote indigenous communities (KAT) that live in the forest in Jambi. However, since the inclusion of production forest land plantations (HTI) in the area of life Orang Rimba, they gradually affected. Orang Rimba often do not benefit from the development process.

The purpose of this study to reveal how political culture which is owned Orang Rimba. More specifically, the study reveals how the political orientation of the Orang Rimba to the object input and output in a land dispute HTI using qualitative description. The data collection was done by interview, observation and documentation.

These results indicate that, the type of political culture Orang Rimba belong to the type of subject - parochial. The mixed type is more likely to be dominated by parochial orientation. The characteristics of the political orientation of Orang Rimba no interest towards the objects of a broad political, except in relation to the values that are believed. Such as orientation to the land HTI Wana Perintis is

based on the belief Orang Rimba, the land was their possession with signs of customary land.

Orang Rimba orientation towards political input object are characteristics parochial orientation. On the political orientation known that insight and awareness of passive political input. So as to influence the political system still has a dependency on the structures of political input to the environment in which they related narrowly. Then the orientation of the political output, Orang Rimba can assess with juice like it or not against government policies. However, it tends to be subjective assessment due to their cognitive aspects which are still dominated by the old values.
