Stress is response to adapt and organize internal and external pressures. Sources of stress can be either biological, physical, psychological, and chemical. Sexual dysfunction can be caused by psychological factors due to high stress. Financial, family, death, and illness can make a woman depressed and experience sexual dysfunction, and affecting harmony in the household.

This study aims to determine correlation of stress according to the scale of social readjustment rating scale with incidence of sexual dysfunction in women of productive age couples in Puskesmas Kota Karang Teluk Betung, Bandar Lampung. This study is an analitic-corelative study with cross sectional design, conducted on November 2013 on 77 respondents using consecutive sampling. The results is 68,84% women of productive age couples experience stress with sexual dysfunction. Characteristics figures mostly in old age and low education.

There is correlation between stress and the incidence of sexual dysfunction in women of productive age couples with p value=0,000.
