THE COMPARISON OF THE INCIDENCE OF SEXUAL DYSFUNCTION ACCORDING TO THE FSFI SCORING ACCEPTOR IUDs AND HORMONAL AT PUSKESMAS RAJABASA IN BANDAR LAMPUNG

Female sexual dysfunction is an important reproductive health issues as they relate to survival and reproduction affect the harmony between husband and wife. Female sexual disorders are divided into four categories of interest (desire disorders), lust (arousal disorder), orgasm (orgasmic disorder), and pain sexual (sexual pain disorder). The aim of this study to compare the incidence of sexual dysfunction according to the FSFI scoring between IUD and hormonal contraceptives acceptors at Puskesmas Rajabasa in Bandar Lampung.

This study is analitic correlative with the cross-sectional approach with consecutive sampling technique. The study was conducted in October-November 2013, with 110 people respondents for each type of contraception.

The result of this study is that the prevalence of sexual dysfunction in fertile aged couples in Puskesmas Rajabasa Bandar Lampung on hormonal acceptor 75 (68.18%), and IUD acceptors 23 people (20.91%). The incidence of hormonal acceptors sexual dysfunction is higher than IUDs and there is a significant difference with $p = 0,000$.
