

ABSTRACT

SCATTERING PROBLEMS IN THE OPTIMALIZATION OF THE REGION'S MINING POTENCY (A CASE STUDY IN REGION OF TANGGAMUS)

This research aims to describe and identify the problems in optimization of mining potency in the region of Tanggamus, to identify and analyze what strategies have been chosen by the Local Government of Tanggamus in managing mining potency in the region. The method used is descriptive research with a qualitative approach. Data collection techniques used are depth interview and documentation.

Results of the research show that the complication in optimization of mining potency in the region of Tanggamus consisted of two main points, *first* is internal problem which included the lack of professional and skilled employees, insufficient promotion and networking in mining resources, the single concentration of a certain mining type, the limited fund for the human resources development, and the unsupported facilities and material. *Second*, is the external problems, e.g. The large number of illegal mining activity, condition of geographical topography, devastation of nature, and the lack of awareness of the companies to conduct their obligation of reporting the financial report of their mining activity. The strategy that was taken into account by the local government of Tanggamus were upgrading the skill of the public servants who take care of mining administration, increasing supervision and fostering the mining companies an illegal mining companies, developing promotion and network by building a website about mining resources, and the last is strengthening the law for illegal mining companies.
