Indonesia is a democratic country. To bring Indonesia into a democratic government, therefore general election becomes a medium for the people to declare sovereignty. By the presence of constitution No. 32 year 2004 concerning Regional Government, therefore central government has been delegating authority to Local Government to regulate and to govern its regional affairs.
