This type of research used in this study is a qualitative data collection method of observation, in-depth interviews and literature study. The data analysis is done by means of data reduction, data display and drawing conclusions and verification. From the results indicate that the interaction penelitim villagers Balinuraga post conflict tend to be incorporating, among other things: cooperation, accommodation, assimilation and acculturation. In post-conflict life in village communities Balinuraga also contained a form of interaction that is divorce between the two sides which is an obstacle to be able to implement such a good interaction process, competition and controversy. After the conflict has changed the lives of the villagers of Balinuraga towards a better social life, especially in group life, religion and culture.
