University of Lampung has a sambar deer inhabited by five male deer doe and two tails. One of the goals of this deer is made to ensure the survival of the sambar. Sambar deer can breed in captivity is necessary for sexual behavior sambar. The purpose of this study was to determine the Sexual Behavior Sambar (Cervus unicolor) deer in Lampung University. Research has been conducted on captive deer Unila in May-June 2013 and the observation time at 6:00 to 18:00 pm with using scan sampling method. Results showed sexual behavior sambar are: Lingga (3.24%), Kiki (1.48%), Farid (1.28%), Ben (0.79%), Farida (0.69%), the Supreme (0.09%) and Danang (0%).
