REGION ORIGINAL REVENUE, GENERAL FUND ALLOCATION, AND SPESIFIC FUND ALLOCATION TO REGIONAL EXPENDITURE IN LAMPUNG PROVENCIAL GOVERNMENT (YEARS 2001-2012)

The purpose of this study is to demonstrate empirically the effect of region original revenue, General fund allocation, and specific fund allocation against expenditure in lampung provencial government. The data used is the realization of PAD, DAU, DAK Lampung Province. Data sourced from the Directorate general of sharing revenue years 2001-2012.

Analysis of data by using multiple regression analysis and first tested the classic assumption. Based on these results it can be concluded that the original income, general fund allocation, and specific fund allocation affect expenditure during the period 2001-2012. Region original revenue effect on regional expenditure in Lampung provencial government. General fund allocation positive effect on local spending, though still small funds obtained from DAU so has not contributed greatly to the regional expenditure. And DAK has contributed greatly to regional expenditure in Lampung provencial government.
