The purposes of this study are (1) To assess the forms of money politics in Governor of Lampung in Bandar Lampung 2014. (2) To examine and analyze the barriers of Bawaslu in monitoring violations of Lampung Governor Election 2014. The stage of data analysis in this study includes data reduction, data organization, and interpretation.

Monitoring the implementation process by Bawaslu tends to follow the pattern already set by the Perbawaslu 2009 Act. Forms of money politics can be groceries, or cash. The actors of Money Politics tend not to do it directly but through a success team and community leaders who have influence, both from the local officials and community leaders. Agreements made with the exchange of votes with money spent by unscrupulous Money Politics actors. Like a knife one-eyed, sharp under and blunt above, enforcement by Bawaslu tend to come from within the rules are so convoluted Bawaslu themselves and many provide crevices for individual offenders and criminal of election.
