PERSEPSI MASYARAKAT KELURAHAN BANDAR JAYA BARAT TERHADAP CALON LEGISLATIF EKS KORUPTOR

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui dan menjelaskan persepsi masyarakat kelurahan Bandar jaya Barat terhadap calon legislatif eks koruptor. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif dengan pendekatan kuantitatif. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah masyarakat lingkungan III Kelurahan Bandarjaya Barat. Instrumen pengumpulan data menggunakan angket dan analisis data menggunakan rumus interval dan persentase. Berdasarkan hasil penelitian pada indikator Pemahaman masyarakat terhadap calon anggota legislatif eks koruptor dikatakan paham diperoleh sebanyak 36 responden (50,00%). Tanggapan masyarakat terhadap calon anggota legislatif eks koruptor dikatakan tidak setuju diperoleh sebanyak 32 responden (44,44%). Harapan masyarakat terhadap calon anggota legislatif dikatakan tidak setuju diperoleh sebanyak 46 responden (63,88%)

ABSTRACT

COMMUNITY PERCEPTION OF BANDAR JAYA BARAT IN THE LEGISLATIVE CANDIDATE EF EX-KORUPTOR PIO AMALIA

This study aims to determine and describe the perception of the community of West Bandar Jaya village towards ex-corruptors to be legislative candidates. This study applied descriptive method with quantitative approach. The population in this study consisted of the Community Environment III of West Bandar Jaya village. The data collection instrument was carried out using questionnaire while the data analysis was done using interval and percentage formulas. Based on the results of the study on the indicator of public understanding regarding former convicts of corruption to be the participants of legislative candidates, the number of respondents who have the understanding was 36 respondents (50.00%). While 32 respondents (44.44%) disagreed with former corruptors being the legislative candidates. From the percentage who disagreed, the public who gave expectations for the legislative candidates was 46 respondents (63.88%)
