ABSTRACT

DEVELOPMENT OF INCOME INEQUALITY IN LAMPUNG PROVINCE AND AFFECTING FACTORS (2001 - 2012)

In an economic development are some of the indicators used to assess the success or failure of such development. Income inequality between regions is one of the indicators used to assess the success. Inter-regional income inequality itself is a measure used to describe the inequality in income from each region.

The purpose of this research was to determine the classification of each county/city in the province of Lampung based Typology Klassen and to determine how per capita income, investment, and unemployment affects income inequality in the Lampung Province in the period 2001 to 2012 were calculated based on the williamson index. The method used in this study is Ordinary Least Square or method of least squares.

From the results it can be concluded that income inequality between regions have occurred in the province of Lampung. This is evident from the results of the analysis indicate that the per capita income, investment, and unemployment, either partially or together, significantly affect income inequality in Lampung Province.
