

**PENGARUH APBDES TERHADAP INDEKS DESA MEMBANGUN (IDM) DAN
INDEKS KETAHANAN LINGKUNGAN (IKL) DI KABUPATEN
LAMPUNG SELATAN**

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ABSTRAK

Tujuan Penelitian ini dilakukan untuk mengetahui dan menganalisis pengaruh PADes, DD, ADD, Dana Bagi Hasil, Dana Lain-lain, Luas Wilayah Desa, dan Jumlah Penduduk Desa, terhadap Indeks Desa Membangun. belanja Bidang Pemerintahan Desa, Belanja Bidang Pembangunan Desa, Belanja Bidang Pembinaan Kemasyarakatan Desa, Belanja Bidang Pemberdayaan Masyarakat Desa, Belanja Bidang Penanggulangan Bencana dan Keadaan darurat Desa terhadap Indeks Ketahanan Lingkungan di Kabupaten Lampung Selatan. Penelitian ini menggunakan pendekatan kuantitatif dan pengujian dalam penelitian ini menggunakan regresi linier berganda dengan uji t dan uji f pada level signifikansi 10% ($\alpha=0,1$).

Hasil penelitian ini membuktikan bahwa secara simultan PADes, DD, ADD, Dana Bagi Hasil, Dana Lain-lain, Luas Wilayah Desa, dan Jumlah Penduduk Desa, berpengaruh nyata terhadap Indeks Desa Membangun. Secara parsial Variabel yang berpengaruh nyata terhadap Indeks Desa Membangun adalah variabel Dana Desa),Alokasi Dana Desa, Dana Bagi Hasil dan Retribusi, dan Jumlah Penduduk. Variabel PADes, Dana lainnya, luas wilayah tidak berpengaruh nyata terhadap Indeks Desa Membangun.

Sedangkan hasil penelitian secara simultan belanja Bidang Pemerintahan Desa, Belanja Bidang Pembangunan Desa, Belanja Bidang Pembinaan Kemasyarakatan Desa, Belanja Bidang Pemberdayaan Masyarakat Desa, Belanja Bidang Penanggulangan Bencana dan Keadaan darurat Desa berpengaruh signifikan terhadap Indeks Ketahanan Lingkungan. Secara parsial variabel yang berpengaruh signifikan terhadap Indeks Ketahanan Lingkungan adalah variabel belanja bidang pembangunan desa dan belanja bidang penanggulangan bencana dan keadaan darurat desa. Variabel belanja bidang pemerintahan desa, belanja bidang pembinaan masyarakat, belanja bidang pemberdayaan tidak berpengaruh terhadap Indeks Ketahanan Lingkungan.

ABSTRACT

The Effect of APBDes on the Building Village Index (BVI) and the Environmental Resilience Index (ERI) in the Regency of South Lampung

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The goal of this study was to determine and assess the impact of PADes, DD, ADD, Profit Sharing Funds, Miscellaneous Funds, Village Area, and Villagers on the Building Village Index. spending on village government, expenditure on village development, expenditure on village community development, expenditure on village community empowerment, expenditure on disaster management, and expenditure on village emergencies to the South Lampung Regency Environmental Resilience Index This study took a quantitative approach, and the test employed multiple linear regression using a t test and a f test at a 10% significance level ($\alpha = 0.1$).

The results of this research reveal that PADes, DD, ADD, Profit Sharing Funds, Miscellaneous Funds, Village Area, and The Number of Villagers all have a genuine influence on the Building Village Index at the same time. The factors Village Funds, Village Fund Allocation, Profit Sharing and Levy Funds, and Population have a real influence on the Building Village Index. Variables such as PADes, other Funds, and territorial area have no actual impact on the Building Village Index.

Meanwhile, the results of a simultaneous research of village government expenditures, village development expenditures, village community empowerment expenditures, disaster management expenditures, and village emergency had a significant effect on the Environmental Resilience Index. The factors that have a substantial influence on the Environmental Resilience Index are partially expenditure on village development and spending on disaster management and village emergency. The factors of spending on village governance, expenditure on community development, and spending on empowerment had no influence on the Environmental Resilience Index.
