

ABSTRACT

STUDY OF LOW PARTICIPATION HUSBAND COUPLES OF CHILDBEARING AGE (EFA) AS AN ACCEPTOR FAMILY PLANNING SUB IN VILLAGE TANJUNG SARI NATAR DISTRICT SOUTH LAMPUNG REGENCY YEAR 2014

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Family planning is an attempt to regulate and restrict the birth. The family planning program has the goal of fertile couples (EFA). However, during this EFA participating as acceptors is still dominated by the wife alone in contrast to the EFA husband whose participation is still less to be acceptors. This study aims to determine the causes of the low participation of EFA husband as acceptors in Tanjung Sari Natar District of South Lampung. This study used a descriptive method. Population and sample in this study were 37 respondents, all of whom are EFA husband having children at least one person. Collecting data with structured interview techniques and documentation. Data analysis was performed using one way table percentages and cross tables (Cross Tab).

The results showed the cause of the low participation of fertile couples husband as acceptors in the village of Tanjung Sari is, (1) the husband couples of childbearing age have less knowledge about family planning (2) husband couples of childbearing age have a low income (3) husband couples of childbearing age have a positive perception of the value of the child (4) and husband couples of childbearing age have a negative attitude towards contraception.
