Changes in the structure or economic transformation from traditional to modern can be generally defined as a change in the economy related to the composition of employment, production, trade, and other factors necessary to continuously improve the income and social welfare through increased income per capita. Economic conditions Kabupten South Lampung in development continues to change.

Component number of shift share analysis of labor South Lampung shows that trade has the most percentage in absorbing labor at 37.00 per cent followed by 29.00 per cent of the service sector. While the agricultural sector and the industrial sector decreased by 27 percent and 6 percent for the industrial sector. This shows that the agricultural sector has experienced a shift contribution to employment.

Component number of shift share analysis of Gross Regional Domestic (GDP) showed positive Lampung Province. Trade sector has a percentage of the value of the most significant shift in contributing to GDP in South Lampung amounting to 50.11 per cent, followed by the services sector kontribisi developmental changes at 26.18 percent, followed by 23.66 per cent of the agricultural sector and the industrial sector of 0.02 percent.
