(Study on Villager at Karet Kavling Village of Sepatan District Tangerang Regency)

Villagers of 07/03 Complex in Karet Kavling Village of Sepatan District Tangerang Regency tend to lack awareness of environmental conservation and village location close to the plant vulnerable to air pollution, but Villagers in this village is one of the goals of socialization One Man One Tree (OMOT) Program. Program. It is based on data from 76 respondents: 12 (15.79%) of respondents

have a perception that is not good toward OMOT Program, 49 (64.47%) of

respondents had an unfavorable perception toward OMOT Program and only 15

(19,74%) of respondents have a good perception toward OMOT Program. (2) The

perception of Villagers in Karet Kavling Village of Sepatan District Tangerang

Regency toward OMOT Program was included in the unfavorable category can be

caused by lack of knowledge of villagers on issues relating to the program such as

socialization in the form of education and the media, the background of program,

objectives of program, importance of program, targets and shapes of OMOT

Program.
