

ABSTRAK

PERSEPSI GURU TERHADAP PERILAKU MEROKOK PADA KALANGAN REMAJA PUTRI (Studi Di SMA Fransiskus Bumimanti)

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Meningkatnya perilaku merokok di kalangan remaja putri menjadi isu sosial karena menentang norma budaya dan moral tradisional. Penelitian ini mengkaji persepsi guru terhadap siswi perokok serta respons siswi di SMA Fransiskus Bumimanti, Bandar Lampung, menggunakan pendekatan kualitatif deskriptif melalui wawancara, observasi, dan dokumentasi dengan enam guru dan empat siswi perokok aktif. Hasil menunjukkan guru cenderung memiliki persepsi negatif terkait penurunan moral, kurangnya pengendalian diri, dan penyimpangan dari norma feminin, meski beberapa guru, terutama guru BK, menerapkan pendekatan edukatif dan empatik. Siswi perokok merespons beragam, mulai dari penyesalan dan upaya berhenti hingga sikap acuh atau penilaian adanya bias gender. Persepsi guru dipengaruhi budaya, agama, dan pengalaman pribadi, serta berperan dalam membentuk sikap, citra diri, dan penyesuaian perilaku siswi di sekolah.

ABSTRACT

TEACHERS' PERCEPTIONS OF SMOKING BEHAVIOR AMONG FEMALE ADOLESCENTS

The increasing smoking behavior among female adolescents has become a social issue as it challenges traditional cultural and moral norms. This study examines teachers' perceptions of female student smokers and the students' responses at SMA Fransiskus Bumimanti, Bandar Lampung, using a descriptive qualitative approach through interviews, observation, and documentation with six teachers and four active student smokers. Results indicate that teachers generally hold negative perceptions related to moral decline, lack of self-control, and deviation from feminine norms, although some, particularly guidance counselors, apply more educational and empathetic approaches. Student smokers show varied responses, from regret and efforts to quit to indifference or perceiving gender bias. Teachers' perceptions, influenced by culture, religion, and personal experience, play a significant role in shaping students' attitudes, self-image, and behavioral adjustment in school.
