

ABSTRACT

COMPARISON *CEPHALIC* INDEX AND HEAD SHAPE BETWEEN LAMPUNGNESE AND JAVANESE MAN IN DESA NEGERI SAKTI LAMPUNG PROVINCE

Human identification has important part in criminal investigation for unidentified victims. One of the way to identify an ethnic or race is measuring the *cephalic* index. This research has done toward Lampungnese man and Javanese man who lives in Desa Negeri Sakti, Lampung on December 2012. *Cephalic* index can be found with measuring the ratio of head's maximum width and length. The results indicated that mean *cephalic* index for Lampungnese man is lower than Javanese's with mean difference is 1,55. Mean *cephalic* index for Lampungnese is pproximately 85,86 and Javanese's is 87,41. Based on each *cephalic* index, both of them can be categorized in *hyperbrachicephal*.
