West Lampung district has a forest area of 397,778 ha total area of 495,040 ha with a population of 419,037 inhabitants. Economic necessity and lack of employment lead to people illegally entering the forest resulting in damage to the forest. Prevention of forest is done by the public welfare through the program approach Forest Plantation. HTR rotated in order to increase the potential for permanent forest production and conserving forest resources. To achieve these objectives it needs the role of West Lampung district forestry office.

Problems in this study how the role of the Forest Service and what inhibiting factors in the management of HTR in West Lampung regency. Juridical approach to the problem through an empirical approach using primary and secondary data. Data collection with library research and field study were then analyzed qualitatively. Forest Service role in the management of the HTR in order to facilitate development include: information dissemination, facilitation in licensing, and conducting the selection of complementary education and training.
